

Schools with Domains or Subdomains

If you have schools that have their own domains (or sub domains), they can also be set up to redirect to their corresponding subsites. You'll need to provide the domain (or sub domain) names and the target subsite names to which they correspond.

Here is an example setup.

In this scenario, *myhighschoolsdomain.myschoolsdomain.org* (the site with its own domain) would be set up to redirect to *www.myschoolsdomain.org/{the_rest_of_the_schoolwires_web_site_path}* and you would configure DNS the same as you would "www" . . . record type CNAME with your existing Schoolwires incubation domain set as the record's content.

Domain/Sub Domain	Record Type	Content
myschoolsdomain.org	A	{IP Address}
www.myschoolsdomain.org	CNAME	{myincubationdomain}.schoolwires.net
myhighschoolsdomain.myschoolsdomain.org	CNAME	{myincubationdomain}.schoolwires.net

This may also closely resemble the response you receive from the Development Operations team, providing you with the specific content values to be used for your DNS setup.
